

From the Superintendent

It's been a very slow start to the golf season this year with either frozen snow covered turf or super-saturated soil from heavy rains. We are eager to get started with the maintenance season, but first a quick note. We had to postpone the drill and fill until a later date because of inadequate conditions. The course needs to be a bit dryer and thawed for the drill and fill to be performed correctly. It is starting to warm up, but with soil temperatures still lower than average it will be a little later for green up and trees budding out.

We have a few things planned this month starting with a fairway weed control application. This will get rid of any weeds that have emerged over the winter and prevent any others from coming up this spring. A deep tine aerification is scheduled for Monday the 10th. The course will be closed all day and will be back open on Tuesday weather permitting. The greens will be a little bumpy for a few days, but will smooth out with rolling daily. Since the soil was dry and firm this fall from the extreme heat and lack of rain during the summer we will be seeding the rough this month to fill in any areas where turf loss occurred. Also there are a few other maintenance items that we will be working on this month. They are repairing and priming the irrigation system, bunker work, applying fertilizer, applying fungicides, and getting the greens prepped for core aerification in April. The irrigation repairs consist of fixing broken heads and repairing a few leaks.

I'm sure everyone is waiting for warm weather just like we are. As for now, with the current course conditions it is very important that everyone follow the cart path rules. Hope to see everyone on the course.

Typically, we play year-round, but this year has been interrupted by "Mother Nature". However, Spring is near, and we will begin playing again soon.

Russ and his crew are doing everything that they can to get the course ready for the season and they need our help. We can best help the course conditions by following these few easy rules of our course.

Fix your own divots plus one more.

Fix your own ball marks plus a few more.

Most importantly, stay on the cart path when it is "Cart Path Only".

This will be our practice most of the spring season. Do not drive on or near the tee box or greens. If you have mobility limitations, red flags may be requested at the pro shop. Otherwise, we request that you adhere to the rules of the golf course. Penalties for infractions are being considered but hopefully will be avoided. The BHCC Golf Course belongs to all of us and it takes us all to maintain it.
